2. **Practice Tests:** This spring, students will be taking the P/SAT. Studies have shown that students who take Practice SAT Tests in Khan Academy get a bump in their Spring SAT scores over students that do not take them.

- Students do not need to finish the test all at once, but they cannot get a score without eventually finishing the entire test
- Students can take one section at a time and can decide when to take each test section. But they cannot pause a section and must finish it within the specified amount of time.
