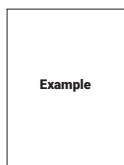


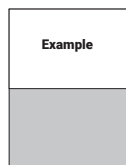

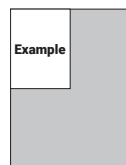

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AD SUBMISSION

Use a credit card, debit card or PayPal by going to yearbookforever.com and entering our school name.

HERE'S HOW:

- Go to yearbookforever.com.
- Search for our school name and click on Shop the Store.
- Select Create a Senior Ad.
- Enter your student's information and your email address.
- Select one of the design options: Have the School Design My Ad, Upload My Finished Ad or Design My Own Ad.
- Select the size and color of the ad you want to purchase.
- Follow the steps to purchase your ad.

Important information for seniors and parents:

Senior portraits — Upload online by Dec. 20

Senior portraits must be submitted online under the Yearbook Snap tab. Go to yearbookforever.com, search for Warren Mott High School and select the Warren Mott High School link to continue. Click on the Yearbook Snap image.



From the Yearbook Snap page:

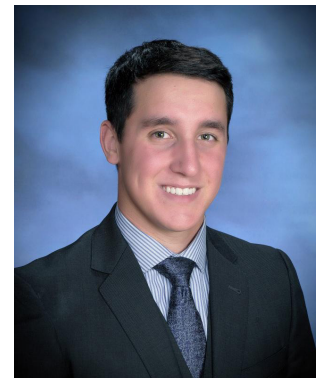
- Enter **mott23** as the access code and select Enter.
- Click on Upload Photo and select a photo to upload from your computer or device.
Make sure your file is 300 dpi.
- Once it uploads, select Portraits from the drop-down menu.
- **Fill in your student's formal name** and click Submit Photos.

IMPORTANT:

- Be advised, the yearbook staff reserves the right to, and will Photoshop, request a retake (at your expense), and/or refuse a photo if all requirements are not met or if the photo is inappropriate.
- You or your photographer must upload your portrait by the due date. This is not the date of your photo shoot. It is the date by which yearbook adviser, Ms. Arcori needs the photo.

SPECS:

- Use the portrait to the right as a guide for sizing, attire and quality.
- Approximately 2x3 in., color retouched photographs, head and shoulders, both eyes showing.
- Distance from top of head to chin is 1.25 in.
- Medium blue/gray/brown background.
- No hands or props showing.
- Soft focus is accepted.
- No shoulders showing or low-cut tops.



Senior Portraits: Due by Dec. 20

- All senior photos must be submitted by the photographer of student to Yearbook SNAP.
- If we do not receive a senior portrait the school ID photo will be used in the yearbook.
- The file must be a JPEG or TIFF format and should be at least 300 dpi..
- In full color only, black & white photos will not be accepted.
- Head-shot only, no cap & gown or "selfie" photos, full body poses will be cropped.
- nclude correct spelling and capitalization of your name in your email.
- **When your photo uploads, select Senior Portraits from the drop-down menu.**

*Be aware that portraits not meeting these guidelines will not be accepted.

IMPORTANT COMPOSITE CLARIFICATION

If you want your senior portrait included in the class composite, and you did not use Prestige as your photographer, you must bring a composite head shot to Prestige with an additional \$20 fee. (Ask your photographer to take this extra shot.) This is the seniors' responsibility, not Ms. Arcori or the yearbook staff's. You must do this personally.

REMINDER: If you use a photographer other than Prestige, the only way to get your portrait on the composite is to personally take it to Prestige at one of the following addresses:
